<u>Iama (Yam) Island DOGIT – Update</u>

The Deputy Mayor requested an update in relation to the recent decisions of the Queensland Minister for Resources with respect to the transfer of the lama Island Deeds of Grant in Trust (DOGIT).

The Chief Executive Officer (Mr James William) recapped for the benefit of Councillors that two formal actions were initiated by Council in response to the Minister's decision:

- An Application for Statutory Order of Review ('Judicial Review Application') was filed on 8 January 2024 and is still in progress; and
- Filing of a stay application on 9 January 2024 to seek an order preventing the Minister from carrying out the Decisions. That stay application was listed for hearing on 22 January 2024 and was subsequently unsuccessful.

The Chief Executive Officer advised that he will be meeting with Council's legal representatives (Moray & Agnew) later this week and following that meeting he will be in a better position to update Council with a current status report in relation to the Judicial Review Application. The Chief Executive Officer will then provide an update to Councillors out of session.

The Chief Executive Officer took the opportunity to introduce to Council the newly-appointed DOGIT Transfer, Land Tenure & Native Title Advisor (Ms Joanne Bryant) to oversee Council's strategies into the future.
